3. **All High school students must attach an official transcript that includes grades, class ranking, and ACT or SAT scores.**
4. Rating of scholarship applications are based on **GPA, extracurricular activities, honors received and financial need. Applicants should list ALL honors and activities from high school, college, community, church and employment.**
5. Applicants must be eligible for admission to NCTC in accordance with existing policies detailed in the current *General Catalog*.
