# TEXAS Grant Program

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## WHO CAN APPLY?

### *Students who are...*

- Texas residents
- have not been convicted of a felony or a crime involving a controlled substance
  - if you have been convicted of a crime involving a controlled substance you may provide proof of one of the following:
    - a certificate of discharge by TDCJ or correctional facility
    - completed a period of probation ordered by the court and at least two years has elapsed from the date of the receipt or completion
    - proof that you have been pardoned or the offense has been expunged from your record.
- show financial need
- have an EFC less than or equal to 4000
- registered for Selective Service or are exempt from this requirement
- **AND**
  - be a recent graduate of an accredited high school in Texas
  - complete the Recommended High School Program or Distinguished Achievement Program
  - enroll in a non-profit public college or university in Texas within 16 months of graduation from a public or accredited private high school in Texas and
  - do not have a bachelor's degree
  - not accumulated more than 30 semester credit hours, excluding those earned for dual or concurrent courses or awarded for credit by examination (AP, IB or CLEP).

### **ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUING IN THE PROGRAM ARE:**

- At the end of the first year, student must meet the satisfactory academic progress criteria set forth in the NCTC Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy.
- At the end of the second year or later, all students must complete at least 75 percent of the hours attempted in the prior award year, have an overall college grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and complete at least 24 semester credit hours per year.
