

Admission Steps

Step One:

Apply for Admission to NCTC through [Apply Texas](#). Complete the college admission process as outlined on the NCTC website: [AdmissionHowtoApply](#)

Have official transcripts from every college you have attended sent to the Admissions Office. Request a Transcript Evaluation. Change your major to **Nursing** by filling out a Maintenance Record form and submit to the NCTC Admissions Office.

Step Two:

Once all admission requirements are met, you will be notified by the Admissions Office of your acceptance to NCTC. You may begin the process of registering for the pre-requisite and general academic (non-nursing) courses if needed. See the Associate Degree Nursing curriculum for the pre-requisite and non-nursing courses.

Step Three:

After you have completed steps one and two, schedule a time to take the [TEAS entrance exam](#). Once testing is done you can complete and submit an online Associate Degree Nursing Application.

Step Four:

To apply to the ADN program, login to the MyNCTC page of the website and under Student Services, select *ADN Application*. Fill out the form and attach copies of your transcripts. Once you have completed all sections of the application along with your TEAS test scores, submit your application.

Application Deadlines:

Generic RN Program

Spring Admission - August 1-31

Fall Admission - March 1-31

LVN to RN Transition Program

Summer Admission – February 1-28

After applications have been processed, each applicant will be notified by email of their status in the Associate Degree Nursing program.
