PREREQUISITE COURSES

To be eligible to apply to the program, students must have completed the following non-nursing coursework with a "C" or higher (cannot be work in progress):

- BIOL 2401 A & P I
- BIOL 2402 A & P II
- MATH 1342 STATISTICS

POINTS REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSION (Applicants will be ranked according to points)

Anatomy & Physiology I	A = 4 Pts	B = 3 Pts	C = 2 Pts
Anatomy & Physiology II	A = 4 Pts	B = 3 Pts	C = 2 Pts

MAX TOTAL: 8 POINTS

Deductions: One point will be deducted for each withdrawal or retake to improve a grade in either A&P course.

TEAS TEST SCORES (Applicants can take the TEAS a maximum of 3 times per calendar year). TEAS Exams can be taken in-person or remotely.

Applicants must score **at least 50%** in each section to qualify. Points awarded per section based on percentage:

Reading	>90=5	>80=4	>70=3	>60=2	>50=1

ADDITIONAL POINTS

Healthcare Certifications (1-point max) – must be official, current and not expired.

Will accept official out of state certifications. (no employer letters will be considered):

- Pharmacy Technician

Non-Nursing Coursework Completion (4 points max):

Must earn a "C" or better in all of the following to earn 1 point for each course completed:

- BIOL 2420 – Microbiology
- PSYC 2314 – Lifespan Development
- ENGL 1301 – Composition I
- 3 credit hour (Language, Philosophy & Culture or Creative Arts Core)

Transcripts will be reviewed for withdrawals, repeats, and academic trends.
