PREREQUISITE COURSES

To be eligible to apply to the program, students must have completed the following non-nursing coursework with a "C" or higher (cannot be work in progress):

- BIOL 2401 – A&P I
- BIOL 2402 – A&P II
- MATH 1342 – Statistics
- BIOL 2420 – Microbiology
- PSYC 2314 – Lifespan Growth & Development
- ENGL 1301 – Composition I
- 3 credit hour (Language, Philosophy & Culture or Creative Arts Core)

POINTS REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSION (Applicants will be ranked according to points)

Anatomy & Physiology I	A = 4 Pts	B = 3 Pts	C = 2 Pts
Anatomy & Physiology II	A = 4 Pts	B = 3 Pts	C = 2 Pts

MAX SUBTOTAL: 8 POINTS

Deductions: One point will be deducted for each withdrawal or retake to improve a grade in either A&P course.

TEAS TEST SCORES (Applicants can take the TEAS a maximum of 3 times per calendar year). TEAS Exams can be taken in-person or remotely.

Applicants must score at least 50% in each section to qualify. Points awarded per section based on percentage:

Reading	>90=5	>80=4	>70=3	>60=2	>50=1
Math	>90=5	>80=4	>70=3	>60=2	>50=1

MAX SUBTOTAL: 20 POINTS

EXPERIENCE: Applicants will be awarded five (5) points for verified hands-on patient care experience as a Licensed Vocational Nurse. To qualify, applicants must have a minimum of six (6) months of direct patient care experience within the last two (2) years in one of the following settings:

- Acute care facility
- Long-term care facility
- Home health
- Home hospice

Home health and home hospice experience must involve direct patient care provided in the field and not office-based duties. Verification of employment and experience must be submitted in the form of a signed letter from the Chief Nursing Officer (CNO), Director of Nursing (DON), or appropriate supervising administrator on official company letterhead. The letter must include the applicant's dates of employment, position held, and confirmation of direct hands-on patient care responsibilities. ***Experience obtained in clinics, schools, offices, or other settings that do not primarily involve direct hands-on patient care will not be accepted for point consideration.***

RESIDENCY: An additional two (2) points will be awarded to applicants whose primary residence is located within Cooke, Denton, Montague, or Young Counties. Proof of residency required.

Transcripts will be reviewed for withdrawals, repeats, and academic trends.

Total points possible: 35
