TEAS REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

TEAS TEST SCORES - Applicants will be ranked according to scores. Prospective students can take the TEAS a maximum of 3 times per calendar year. Scores up to two years from the date of applying will be considered. TEAS Exams must be taken IN-PERSON only (remote scores will NOT be accepted). Points will be used in the event of a tie breaker.

Applicants must score a minimum of 58.7% composite, with at least 50% in each category to qualify. Points awarded per section based on percentage:
