WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

Employers in all industries place high importance on hiring candidates with this skill. Having great Ethical Decision-Making skills will promote trust and create a supportive culture which will benefit any organization.



HOW CAN I GET BETTER AT IT?

- Read and understand your Ethics Policy at school or work
- Actively address/speak up when an ethical issue arises. Don't ignore it.
- Reflect on your words and actions. Do they inspire others to do/be better?



WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF IT?

TIP: Think of examples you might have from your own experience and keep them in mind for when you prepare for interviews!

- · Taking responsibility when you have made a mistake
- Handling sensitive information and keeping it private
- · Reporting something that you know is wrong
- Asking a mentor for help when you have a difficult decision to make
- Being trustworthy with money, supplies, and equipment
- Doing the right thing even if no one is around
