### PRE-REQUISITES

- MUST attend an Info Session
- TEAS Exam - Nursing
- Immunizations (Up to 7 months processing)
- Students can complete either of the following in advance of starting the program but it is NOT REQUIRED:
  - Anatomy and Physiology for Allied Health (VNSG 1420) OR
  - A&P I (BIOL 2401) AND A&P II (BIOL 2402)

- Attendance at an Info Session NOT REQUIRED
- TEAS Exam - Nursing
- Immunizations (Up to 7 months processing)
- 2.5 GPA
- MUST complete the following courses with qualifying grades BEFORE applying
  - Anatomy & Physiology I (BIOL 2401)
  - Anatomy & Physiology II (BIOL 2402)

- HESI Exam (Biology, Reading, and Math)
- Immunizations (Up to 7 months processing)
- MUST complete the following courses with qualifying grades BEFORE Surgical Tech Program begins but may be taken concurrently w/ application semester (Summer)
  - Anatomy & Physiology I (BIOL 2401) AND Anatomy & Physiology II (BIOL 2402)
  - Elementary Statistics (MATH 1342) OR College Algebra (MATH 1314)
  - Composition I (ENGL 1301)
  - Humanities OR Fine Arts Core (3 credit hours)
  - Lifespan Growth and Development (PSYC 2314)
  - Microbiology (BIOL 2420)
  - Medical Terminology (HITT 1305)

- 2.5 GPA

### TIMELINE

- 1 Year Program (FA. SP. SU)
- Traditional Fall Start (August) Apply: January-March
- Traditional & Online/Hybrid Spring Start (January) Apply: May-July

- 2 Year Program for Nursing coursework (once admitted)
- 1 Year program for LVN to RN
- RN program Admissions
  - Fall Start (Apply March 1-31)
  - Spring Start (Apply Aug 1-31)
- LVN to Rn Admissions
  - Summer Start (Apply Feb 1-28)

- 1st and 2nd Semesters are Prerequisites only
- 5 Semester Program (including prerequisites)
- Only admits in the FALL
- Apply: Spring Semester

- 1 Year for Prerequisite classes
- 2 years (w/ Summer) for Radiology Program
- Only Admits in the FALL
- Apply: Spring Semester

### ADDITIONAL INFO

- Campuses (Fall Start)
  - Gainesville, Corinth, Bowie, Graham
- Campuses (Spring Start)
  - Gainesville, Hybrid/Online
- Admission is based on TEAS Exam Scores
- Accepts 30 - 40 Students each semester
- "Online" option requires attendance in Gainesville
- Can transition to ADN

- Campus: Gainesville
- Admission is determined by a points system
- Accepts top 50 students each semester
- Blended Program- Getting your Bachelor's degree and Associate's degree at the same time- TWU & MSU
- BSN Bridge Program has additional pre-requisites and requires 30 Online Hrs w/ a partnering institution

- Campus: Gainesville
- Admission is based on rank and order of HESI exam composite score
- Accepts up to 24 students each year

- Campus: Gainesville
- Admission is determined by a Points System
- Accepts max of 18 - 20 students each year
