5. Bring the documents below to the meeting:

- Copy of current passport- must be valid

- Copy of visa
- Copy of I-94 (available electronically at https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/#/home)
- 2 passport photos taken within the past 6 months (write your name at the back of the photos)

You will send the OPT Packet to USCIS via federal express. The EAD card will be sent to our office, and

- Check or Money Order for \$410 payable to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security
- Copies of any previous Employment Authorization Card (if applicable).
