- ▶ **Apply for Admission** - Complete the NCTC Application for Admission through ApplyTexas. Please submit your application as far in advance of registration as possible.
- ▶ **Submit Transcripts** - Submit WITH your application official transcripts from ANY institutions of higher education you have attended.
- ▶ **Submit TSI Scores** - Turn in either official TSI Assessment scores or an official college transcript bearing TSI status.
- ▶ **Submit Proof of Bacterial Meningitis Vaccine** - Before registering, students under the age of 22 must provide proof of immunization documentation.
- ▶ **Complete Transfer Orientation**

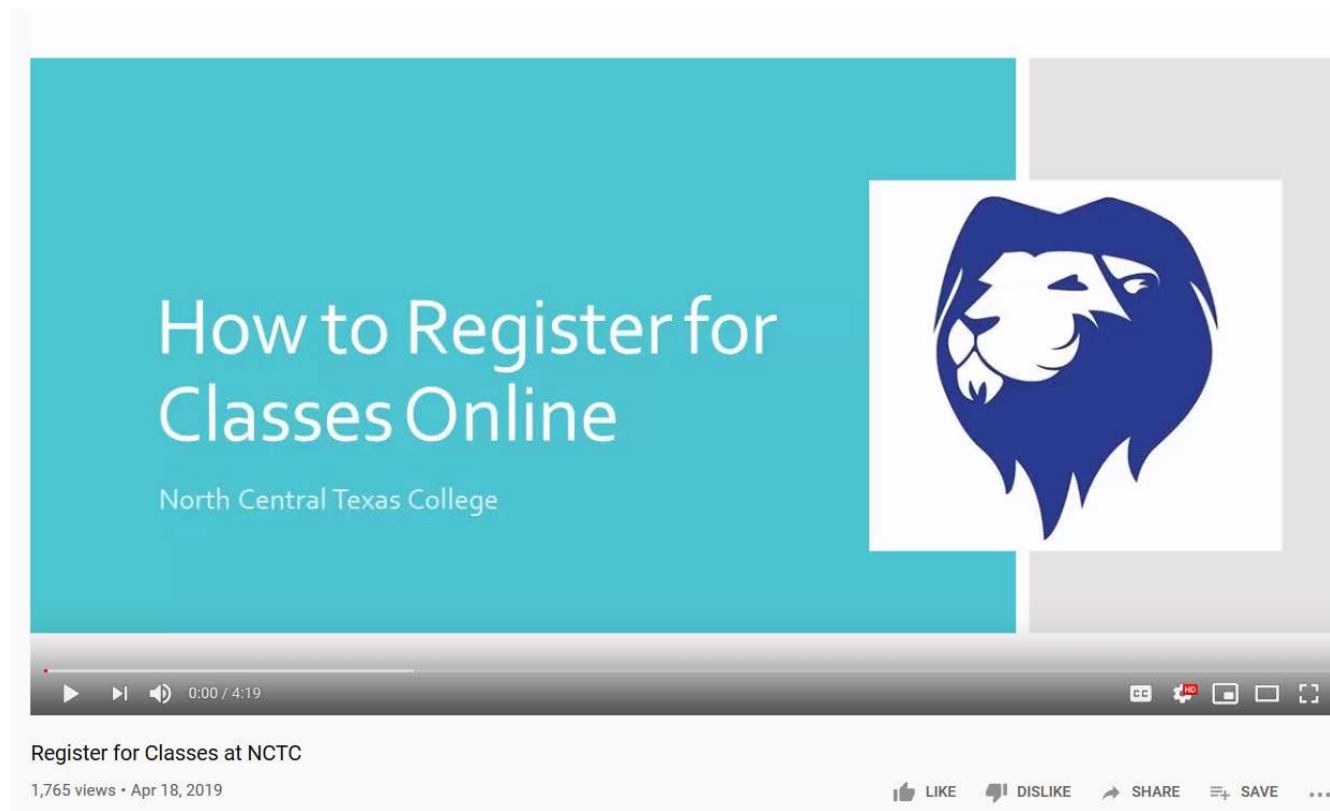
If you need help finding a specific course for your schedule, please follow the 4 steps listed below.

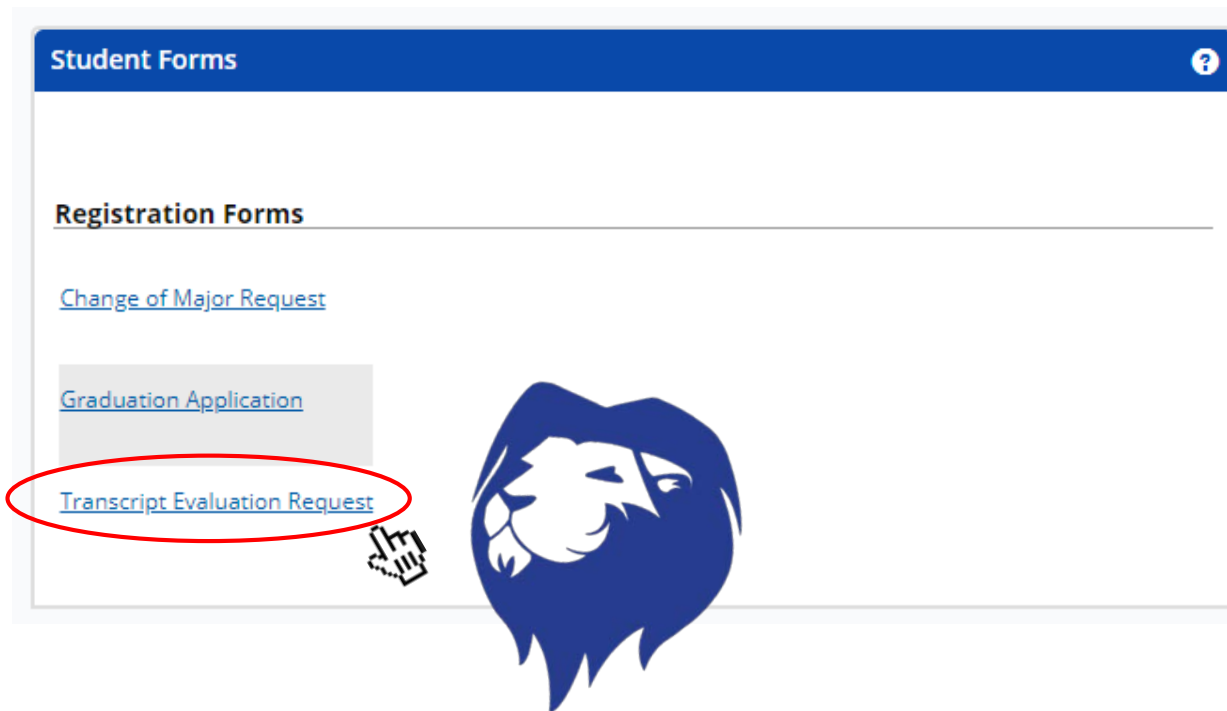




# Don't Forget...

Fill out a **Transcript Evaluation Request Form** so that we can apply previous college credit to your NCTC Transcript. This process is not automatic and can take several weeks to complete, so take care of this step ASAP!

# Grade Point Average

While we may transfer in your credit from another school, NCTC does not transfer in your previous GPA. Each university may calculate GPA differently.

They may also treat repeated coursework differently. It's important that you check with your future university to see how retaking classes at NCTC will affect your cumulative GPA.

# Keep In Mind...

## ▶ Check Course Equivalencies

Classes may have different course numbers than those at your university.

Example: ACNT1303 Introduction to Accounting  $\neq$  ACCT2010 Accounting Principles I

## ▶ Pre-requisite Issues

If your transcript evaluation hasn't been completed yet, then you will need to see an advisor if you are trying to enroll in a class that has a pre-requisite that you've already met.

# Feeling Lost?

We recommend you meet with an advisor to create a degree audit, which will help serve as road map of what classes you need to take.

It's important to note that even if you transfer in everything that is needed for a degree at NCTC, you will still need to complete a certain amount of residency hours in order for us to award you a degree.

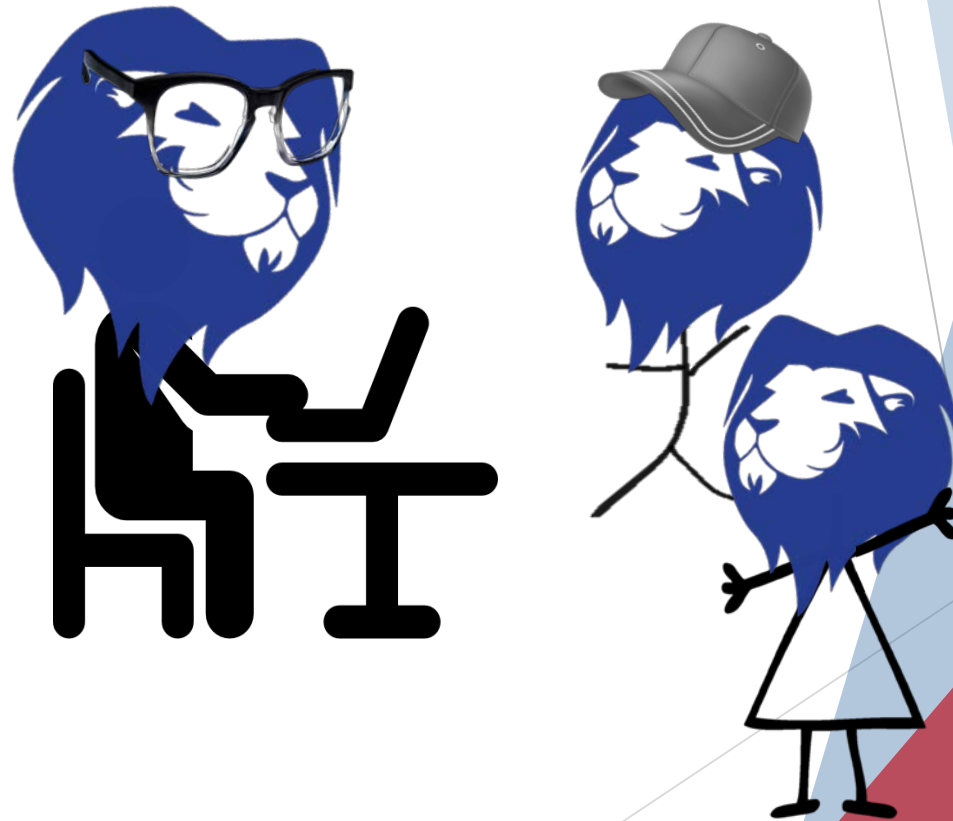

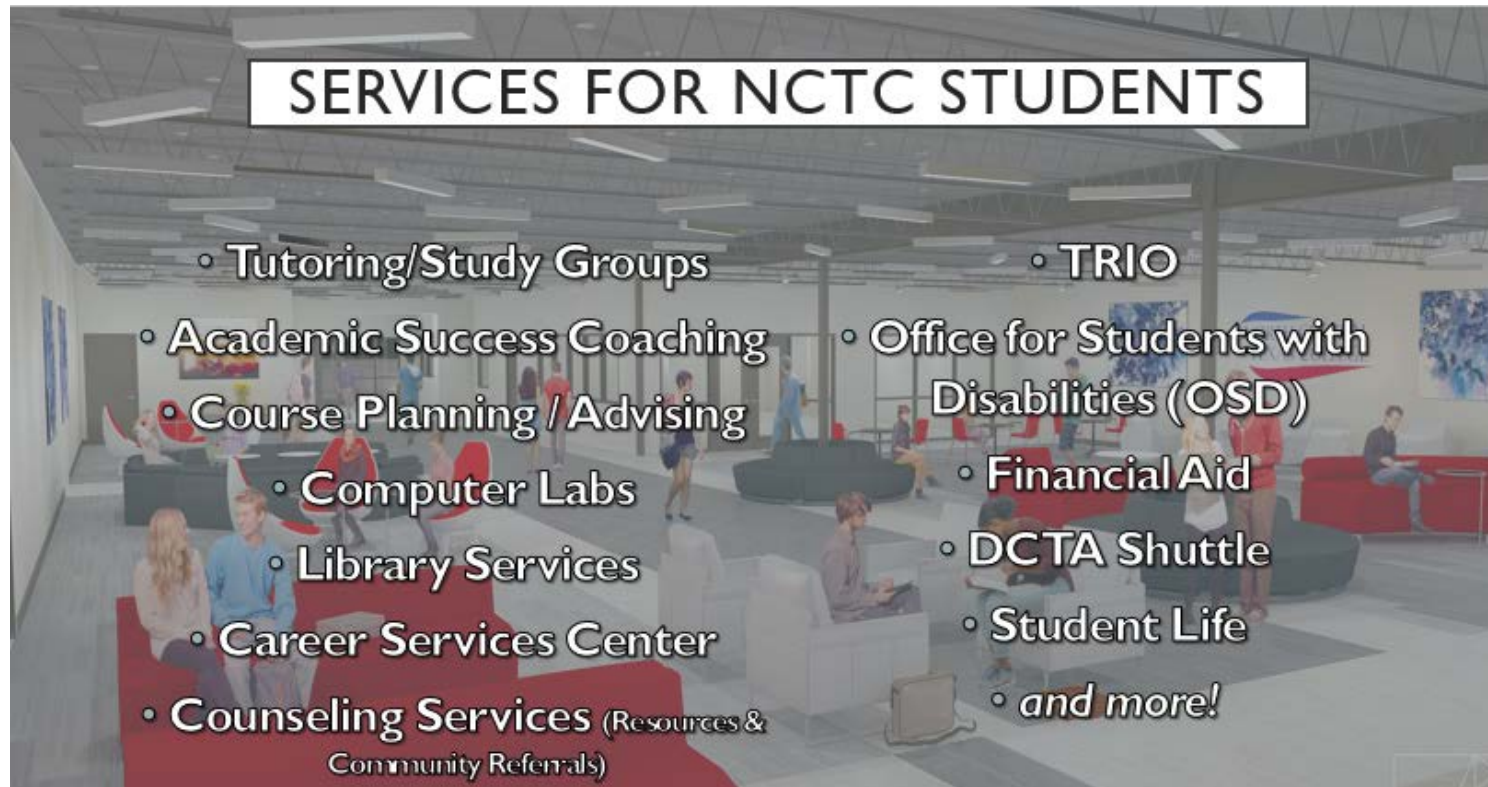
